



DR. NORMAN G. WILSON

During the summer of 1976, Dr. Wilson left the pastoral ministry to assume duties as executive director of The Wesleyan Hour. For more than thirty years, this thirty-minute broadcast was heard over 200 times each week in over 100 countries of the world in English, Russian, and Spanish. It received the National Religious Broadcasters' Award of Merit and Honor Citation. Dr. Wilson served on the NRB's board of directors 1984–2005.

In June of 1992, Dr. Wilson was elected as the first General Director of the newly-formed Department of Communications for The Wesleyan Church World Headquarters. His responsibilities for the denomination, based in Indianapolis, Indiana USA, include serving as the international speaker for The Wesleyan Hour and General Editor of the denomination's quarterly magazine, Wesleyan Life.

In June 2008 Norman retired from General Church responsibilities and continues active ministry in evangelism holding church revivals, camp meetings, conducting seminars and as guest minister in local church pulpits.

Norman Wilson is married to the former Nancy Deyo, a former elementary teacher, former adjunct professor at Indiana Wesleyan University, and speaker for women's groups. They have three children: Beth Pope of Indianapolis, Indiana; Lawrence Wilson of Anderson, Indiana; and Jonathan Wilson of Noblesville, Indiana. The Wilsons have 13 grandchildren.


